

LESSONS FOR THE LITTLE LAMBS

LORD'S DAY, SEPTEMBER 5TH, AD 2010

Toddler (Obedience room): *Daniel and the Lions' Den*

Bible Truth: Daniel 6: King told everyone to pray only to him, not to God. Daniel prayed and trusted God, not the king. King threw Daniel into lions' den. God heard Daniel's prayer. God kept Daniel safe.

Lesson Aim: To learn to talk to God about everything.

Memory Verses: Review: Psalm 9:1a, Psalm 143:10a, Psalm 150:6, Psalm 25:4

First Catechism: Review 1-15.

3 and 4 Year Old (Benediction and Instruction rooms): *God Keeps His Word to Send Jesus*

Bible Truth: God kept his promise to Adam and Eve and others by sending Jesus, the Savior, to redeem his people. (Matthew 1; Luke 1, 2)

Lesson Focus: Just as he promised in his Word, God sent Jesus to save us from our sins.

Memory Minute: "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; his is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:11

5 and 6 Year Olds (Uprightness room) *Depending on God Alone*

Bible Truth: God used Gideon to deliver his people from the Midianites and to teach them again to depend totally upon the Lord. (Judges 6-7)

Lesson Aim: To know that we must depend totally on God to take care of us and give us all that we need.

Memory Work: Review Psalm 121

2nd and 3rd Grade (Sola Scriptura room): *God Gives Eternal Life*

Bible Truth: In heaven, God's people will live with him forever, and he will provide everlasting care for them. (John 14, 16; Revelation 1, 21-22; 1 Corinthians 2)

Lesson Focus: To trust and praise God for the gift of eternal life in Jesus; to look forward to being with Jesus forever; to thank God for his care and provision for us now and forever.

Memory Work: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him." 1 Corinthians 2:9

4th and 5th Grade (Prayer room): *God's Story from Genesis to Malachi*

Bible Truth: Review Genesis to Malachi – God has always had a plan to redeem his people. He works through people and events in history to carry out his redemptive plan.

Lesson Aims: To review God's redemptive dealings with his people from Genesis through Malachi. To explore the time between the Old and New Testaments. To reflect on what we have learned about God and his Word in the Old Testament.

Memory Work: Review Proverbs 2:1-10

Middle School (Sacred Writings room): *A Sad Ending – 1 Kings 9:1-9; 11:1-13*

Central Point: Despite his great blessings, Solomon broke the covenant by turning his heart after other gods.

Student Application: I must identify idols in my own life and recognize my need of Jesus.
